


# “Town Square Park” Project Update



The south end phase will also include installation of an iron gazebo structure that was donated to us from the Estebo Foundation last year. Plans are to raise enough funds to do the hardscape work as well as some landscaping of the south end.

This has been a long process but we are looking forward to seeing actual work done next year that will make the space more usable on a daily basis for the general public and also provide a venue for arts presentations.

Tatanka Arts continues to work on plans to develop an empty corner space in a prominent spot of downtown Redwood Falls. Progress has been made over the last two years as we worked with the City of Redwood Falls to designate the space as a city park, “Town Square Park”, and in developing design ideas with the help of local artist, Gerry Patten and MN Design Team Architect, Patrick Waddick.

Thrivent Financial continues to work in partnership with Tatanka Arts on this project. We have received support from Julie Rath, Redwood Area Development Center, and additional financial support from the Estebo Foundation and the Blandin Foundation. We anticipate an additional contribution from the Thrivent Financial Group this fall. This will initiate a matching funds campaign to raise money for a concrete pour at the south end of the park next summer.
